
Outcomes

- Outcome A: National IP Policy strengthened through consultations and workshops and sui generis GI system development
 - Access and Benefit Sharing workshop
 - Compulsory licenses/TRIPS Flexibilities
 - Study on introducing sui generis GI system
- Outcome B: IPR registration and administration entities provide efficient and user-friendly services
 - Basic patent searches
 - Patent examiners trained on efficiency
- Outcome C: SMME supporting agencies and IPR entities promote protection and use of IPRs to potential users IPRs
 - Web platform for SMMEs is created
 - SEDA expertise on IP is strengthened
 - Key institutions trained on delivery of PE&A activities
 - GI producers are aware of benefits of GI label
- Outcome D: Increased commercialization of IPRs as part of innovation process
 - IP asset holders increase negotiating skills
 - Awareness increased on IP asset valuation
 - Skills increased on IP portfolio management and commercialization

Planned activities:

- Market analysis on the economic potential of South African GIs conducted
- Legal and economic study on the possibility of introducing a GI sui generis system in RSA conducted
- Workshop for governmental officers on the introduction of a sui generis systems and to present the results of the study conducted
- Support of an expert for setting a sui generis GI legislation system (conditional on positive decision after the presentation of the study)
- awareness-raising workshops for interested GI producer groups
